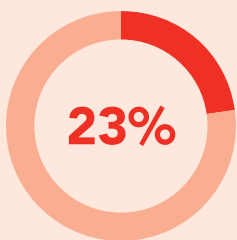


After years of feeling isolated, Denise found community, purpose, and lasting friendships through a program in Prescott-Russell powered by United Way East Ontario.

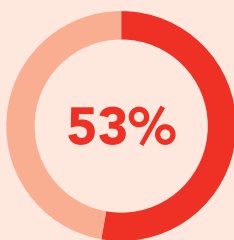

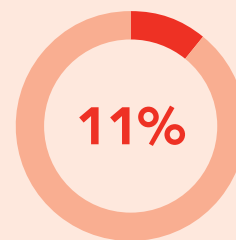
The local facts:*



23% of Prescott-Russell residents reported feeling socially isolated.



53% of students in Grades 7–12 in rural East Ontario reported being bullied because of their weight or body shape.



11% of Prescott-Russell residents indicated having recently experienced suicidal thoughts.
